The OVMA Veterinary Assistant Certification offers two pathways for individuals to earn certification. Applicants may work on the job using experience and a self-paced study program course, or they may complete a program at one of several partnering Oklahoma Career Tech campuses across the state. Participants cover curriculum material, standard skill requirements, and are given preset testing dates to prepare for the exam. After passing the final exam, participants receive a certificate of completion, which renews yearly.
